All Handlers/Riders will be issued with a pass for themselves, plus one for driver and 1 groom. All other admission tickets **MUST** be purchased at £10 per adult.

As far as I am aware at time of compiling this schedule, parking will be the same as 2014, i.e. parking in farmers yard or field opposite the entrance to the warm-up area. There will be one jump in the warm up area for those doing W.H. classes. Full parking details and warm up area details, will be emailed out to everyone at the same time parking passes are emailed out to you. Although this is not a County show, it is laid out and ran on a very similar basis, so please be aware that it is a busy show and there are trade stands, fairground, steam engines and other attractions, although the horse ring is kept as far away as possible from these.

The Fenland Country Fair, takes place on 29th to 31st August, the 3 days of the August Bank holiday, at Stow Cum Quy on the north side of Cambridge, and is accessible and signed from the A14.

This event, now in its 34th year has recently been extended to 3 days, from 2, because of its popularity. It appeals to anybody with an interest in the countryside, young and old alike, retaining its essential old fashioned character, but at the same time continuing to grow.

From bees to fishing, horses to rural crafts and falconry to bygonies, there is something here for everybody.
